General Information

Conference description and goals

2013 is the thirtieth year for the popular *Minnesota Geriatric Care Conference*. The need for education and innovation related to caring for the elderly has grown consistently over the past thirty years, along with the population themselves. As the timeline for care is shortened, the importance of accurate, understandable communication among multiple caregivers, families, and their elderly relatives has become highlighted. The elderly are learning to self-manage their chronic conditions, as well as more acute illnesses. A variety of topics will be addressed at this conference to assist participants to be knowledgeable and flexible in the care and education of patients and their families.

The goals of the conference are to:

- Discuss the importance of good communication among caregivers and patients.
- Describe common symptoms and treatment options for osteoarthritis.
- Address innovations in care for the elderly who have chronic and/or acute illnesses.

The conference will be held **Wednesday**, **April 3**, **2013**, in Mayo Civic Center, 30 Civic Center Drive SE, Rochester, Minnesota.

Conference participants are expected to assume costs related to travel, accommodations, and registration.

To submit an abstract, you must register for the conference at http://calendar.cne-registration.com. Attach the abstract and all presenters' curriculum vitae. Completed abstracts must be submitted by Wednesday, February 6, 2013.

Notification of accepted abstract and commitment for presentation at the conference will be made by **Wednesday**, **February 20**, **2013**. If selected, abstracts will be printed in the conference syllabus.
