Jim Robo is a private investor and former chairman and chief executive officer of NextEra Energy, Inc. and NextEra Energy Partners, LP. During Mr. Robo's 10-year tenure as CEO, NextEra Energy grew to become the largest renewable energy company in the world and has been recognized for its efforts in sustainability, corporate responsibility, ethics, compliance and diversity.

Prior to joining NextEra Energy in 2002, Mr. Robo spent a decade at General Electric Company, serving in roles including president and chief executive officer

of GE Mexico from 1997 to 1999 and as president and chief executive officer of the GE Capital TIP/ Modular Space division from 1999 to February 2002. From 1984 through 1992, he worked for Mercer Management Consulting. Mr. Robo serves on the board of J. B. Hunt Transport Services, Inc. and is the lead director and chairman of its Nominating and Corporate Governance Committee.

Mr. Robo earned a bachelor's degree from Harvard College and an M.B.A. from Harvard Business School.
