

## **Ambulatory Infusion Center/PICC Department Nursing at Mayo Clinic in Florida**

This five-room unit with 10 chairs treats ambulatory patients in all specialties — from dermatology to transplant — who need services such as injections, transfusions and chemotherapy administration.

### **Details**

- Staff actively participates in a Quality Subcommittee that is unit-based.
- The staff includes a team of **RNs, LPNs, patient care technicians** and a **patient service specialist/appointment scheduler**.
- RN care is based on acuity. Teamwork is essential to the success of this outpatient care area.
- Dedicated nurse manager leads and assists staff in improving patient care and staff satisfaction.
- The PICC team works in tandem with the Ambulatory Infusion Center, which serves as the team's home base. Advanced training for the PICC team is available as openings occur.

- 12-hour day shifts
- Flexible alternative shift options
- Full time, part time, supplemental, PRN

### **Requirements**

- Florida R.N. license required upon date of hire
- Hospital nursing experience required
- BLS required
