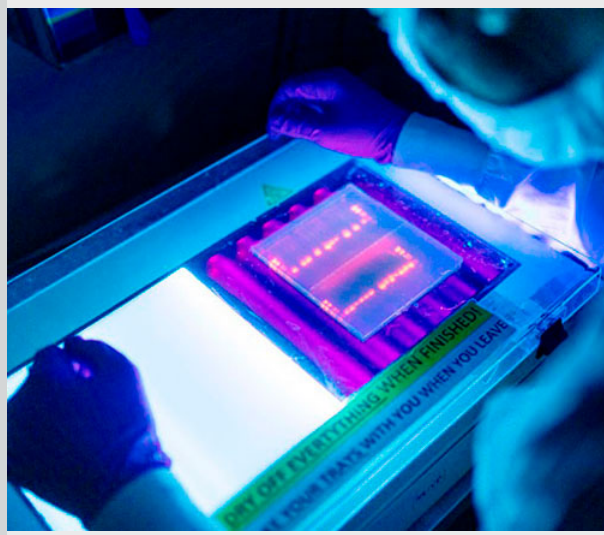

Mayo Clinic physicians evaluated the humoral response to the COVID-19 vaccine in patients with cancer and found a decreased humoral response for patients receiving treatment.

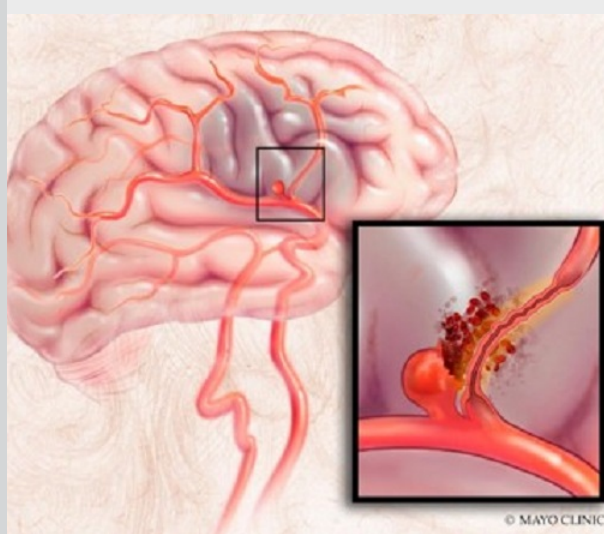

Following preventive care recommendations is extremely important in the management of patients with inflammatory bowel disease (IBD).

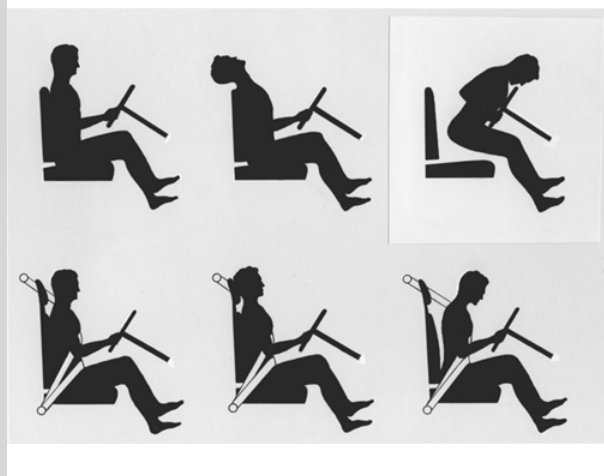
