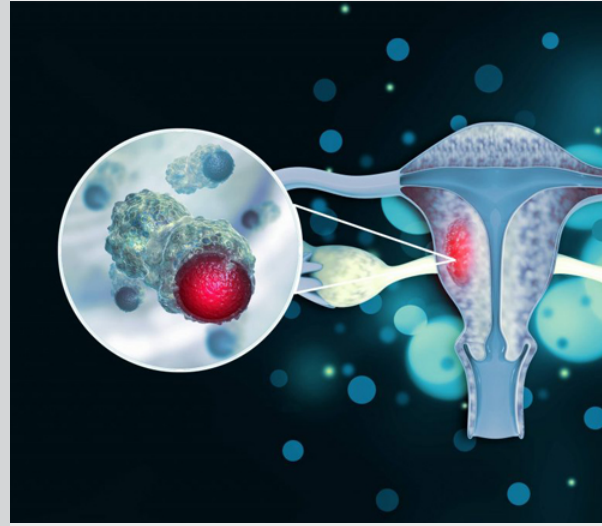
#### Improving quality of life for pediatric patients with sarcoma
