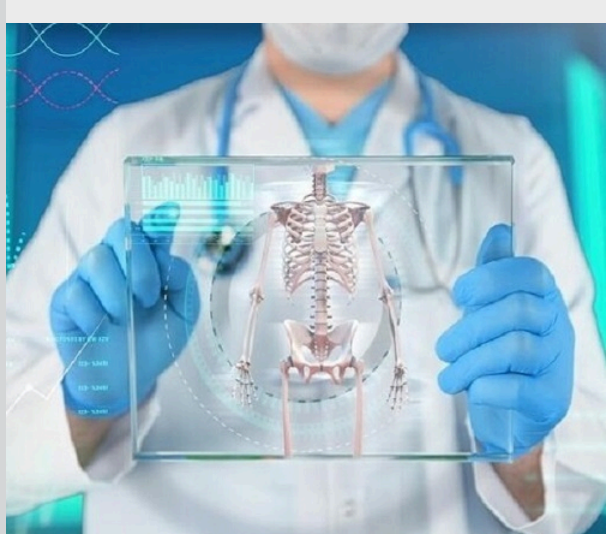

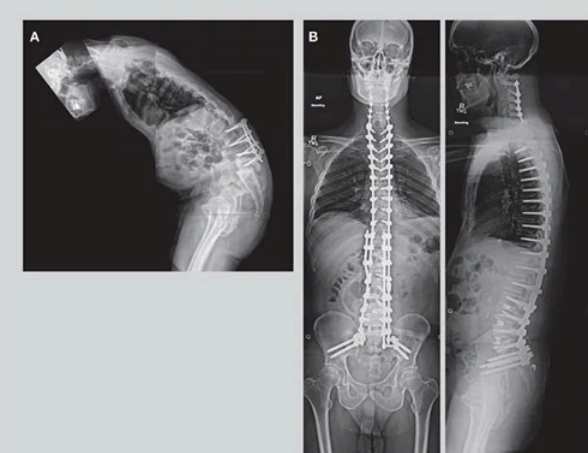

Subspecialists perform spinal deformity surgery

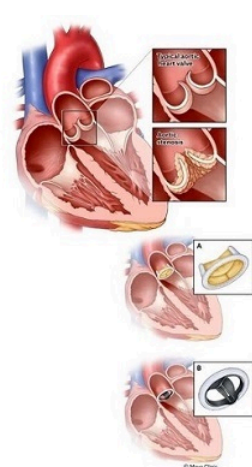

Anticoagulation early reduces mortality after bioprosthetic sAVR

A study in Mayo Clinic Proceedings found that receiving anticoagulation with warfarin early reduced all-cause mortality and thromboembolic events after bioprosthetic sAVR.
