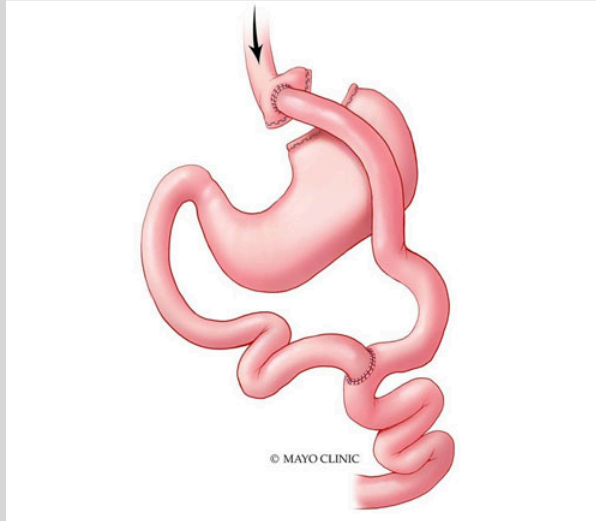

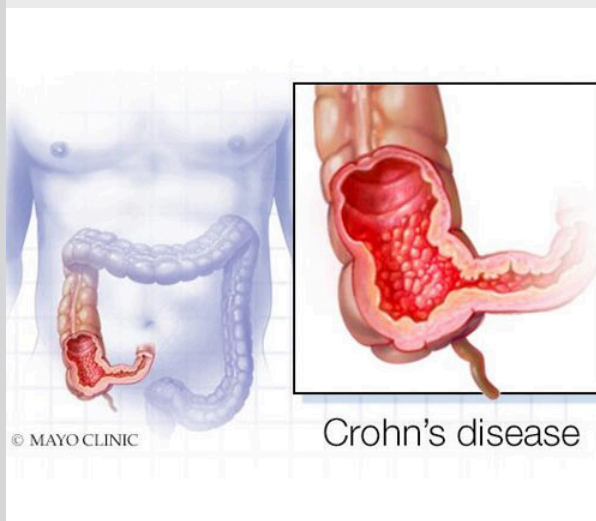

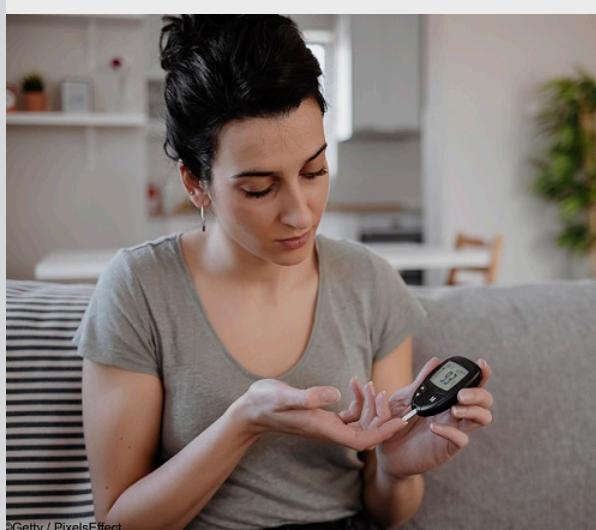

In a population-based study of individuals with newly diagnosed Crohn's disease (CD), researchers analyzed the prevalence of obesity and whether it affects disease phenotype and CD-related outcomes.

Research demonstrates long-term metabolic benefits of Roux-en-Y gastric bypass

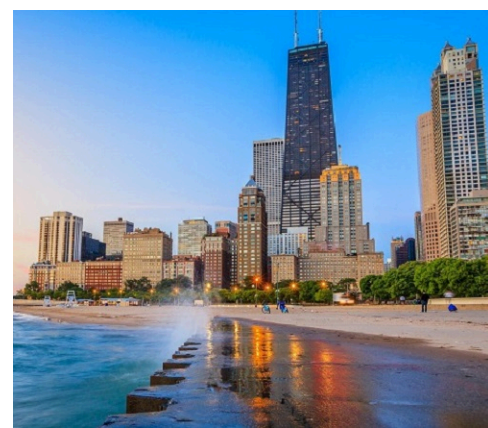
