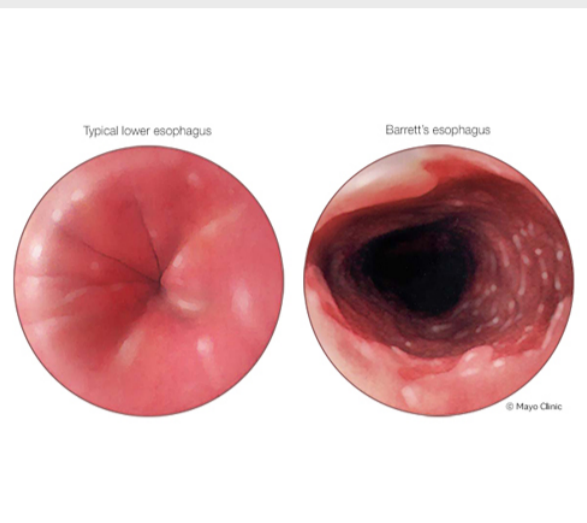

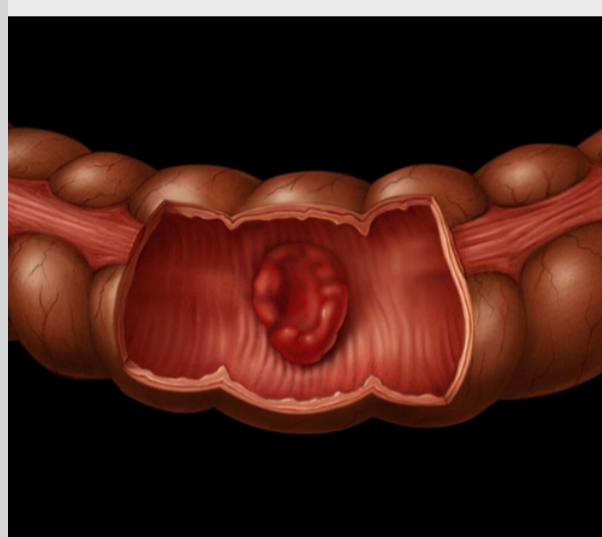

Mayo Clinic researchers study optimal surveillance intervals after endoscopic eradication in patients with Barrett esophagus-related dysplasia or early cancer

Study results suggest that lengthening surveillance intervals would reduce the burden of endoscopic procedures without increasing rate of recurrence.

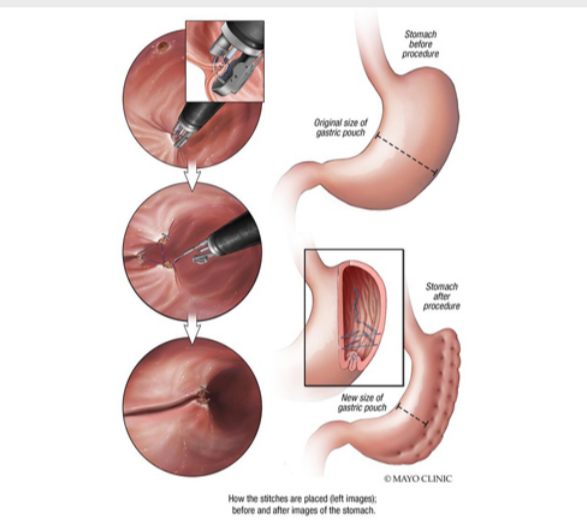

Researchers conclude that prior radiation treatment does not appear to adversely affect mt-sDNA test performance in colorectal cancer screening.

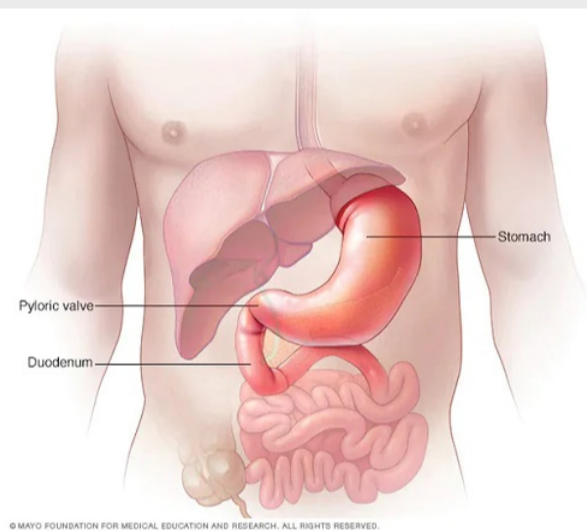
