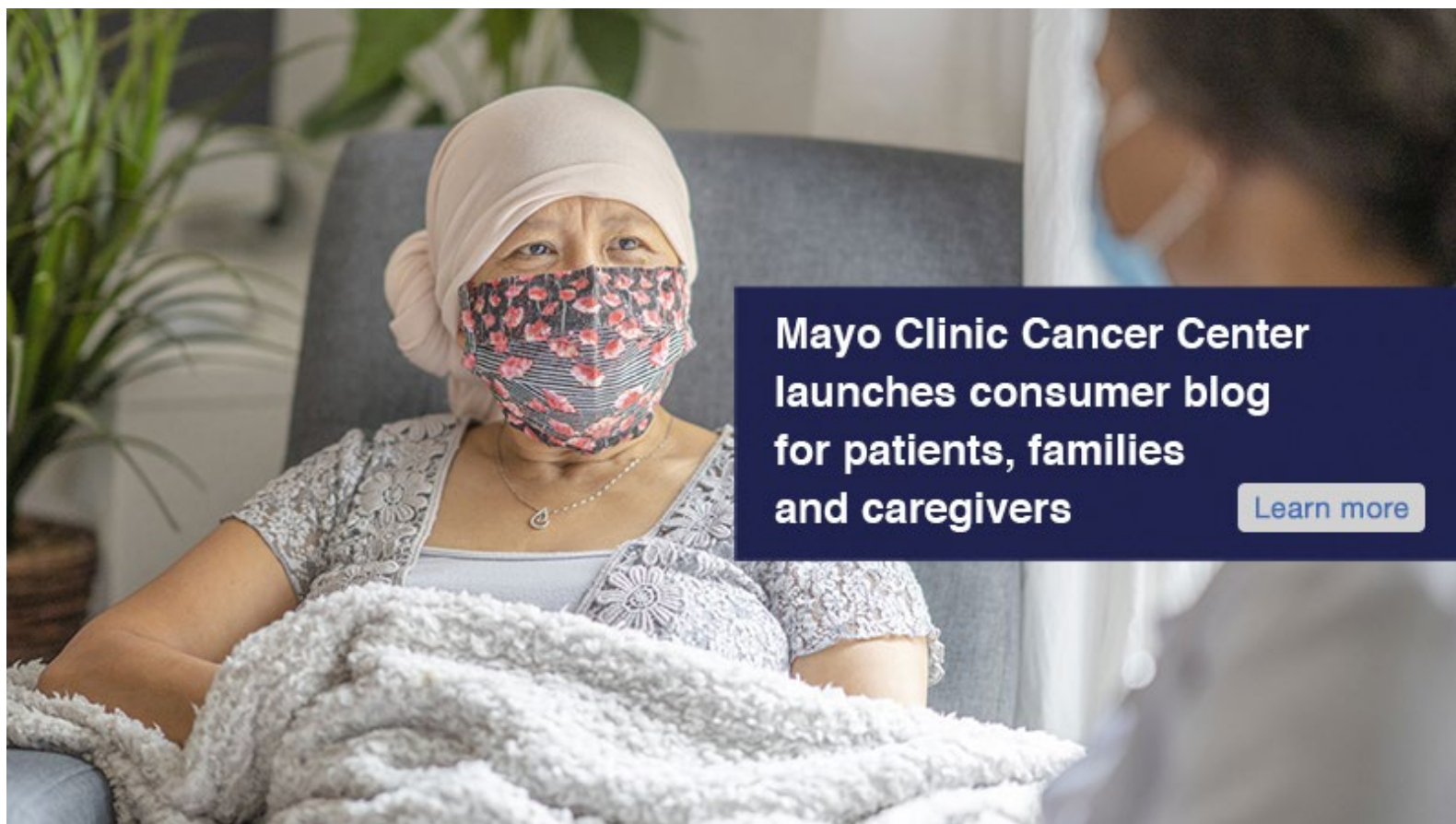

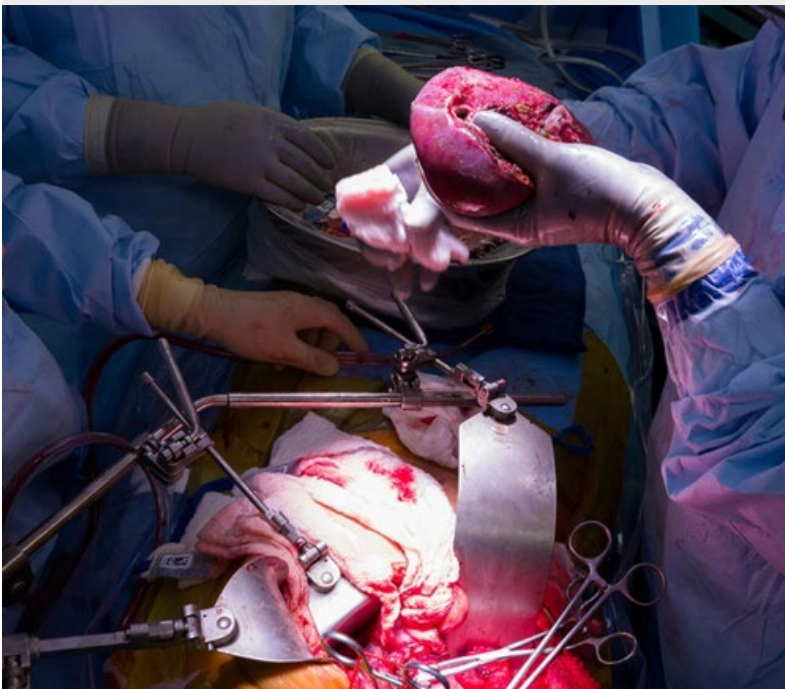

Podcast: Accurate, definitive diagnosis of T-cell lymphoma

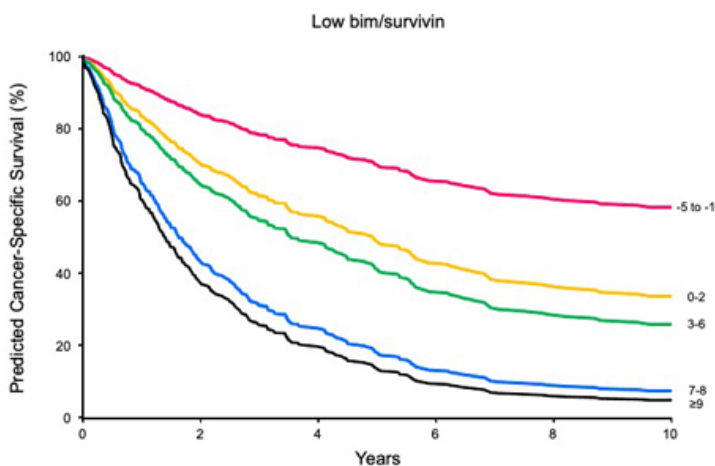

Adding biomarkers Bcl-2 interacting mediator of cell death (BIM) and survivin to previously created clinical metastases scores may improve the prediction of cancer-specific survival.
